



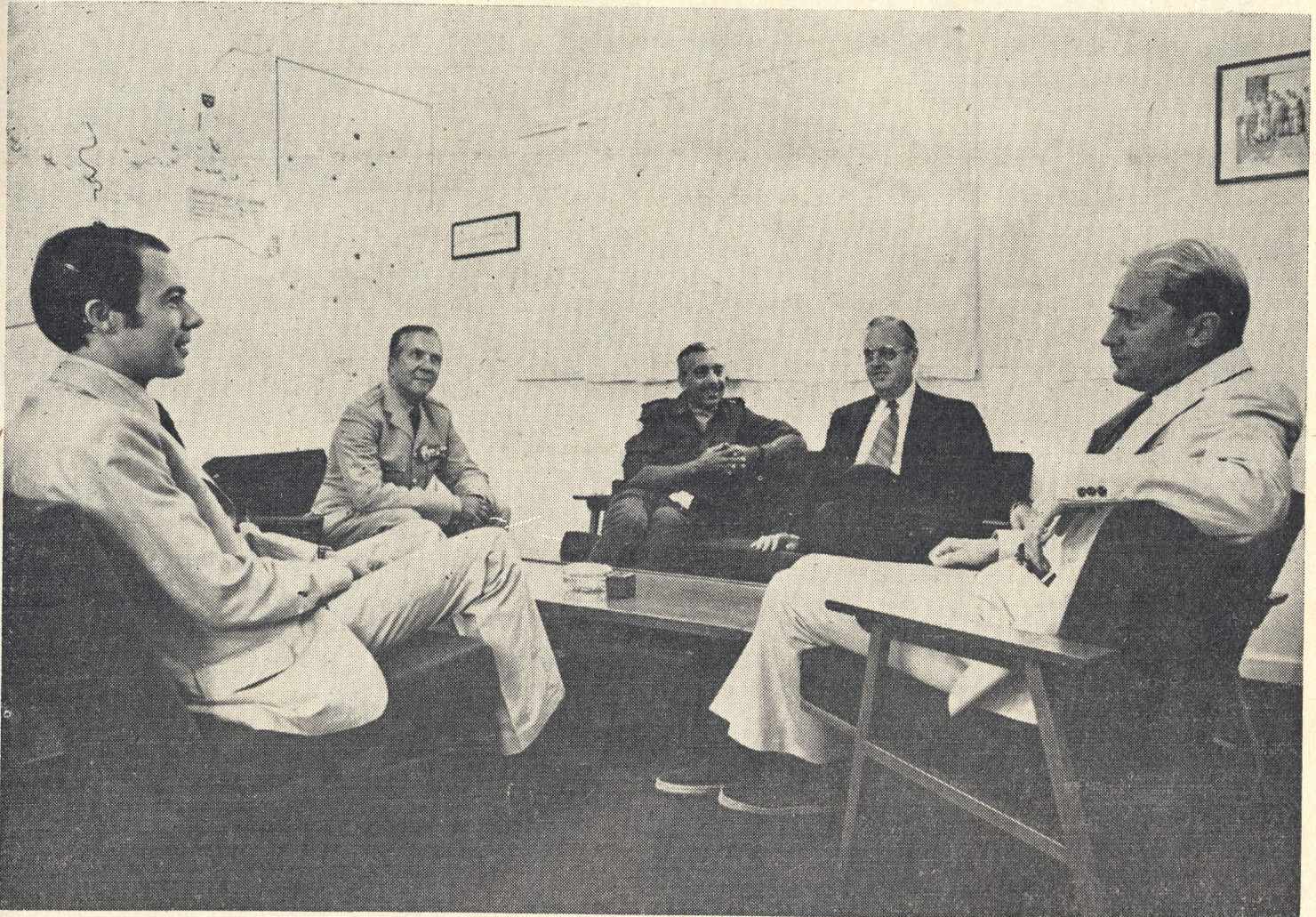

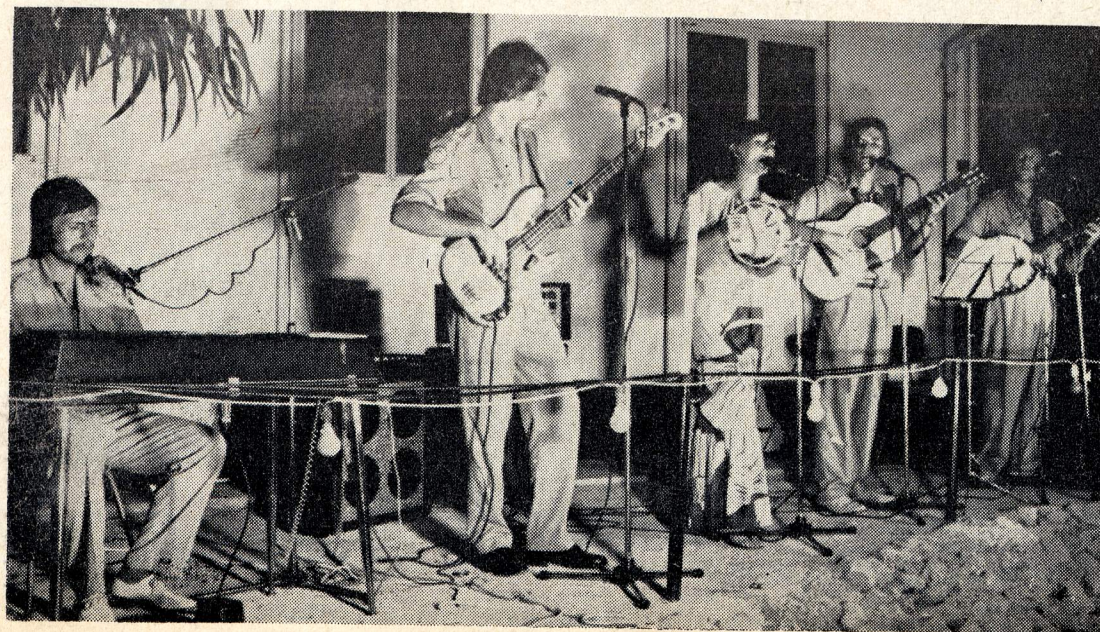

AN AMBASSADORS VISIT

After being the Swedish Ambassador at the United Nations for a few years, Mr Olof Rydbeck had the opportunity to visit the Swedish UN Battalions in the Near East before becoming the Swedish Ambassador in London in October. He began his tour at Carl Gustav Camp, Famagusta, and then visited all the OPs in Sector 6 where he was briefed about their tasks. While he was here Mr Rydbeck told the soldiers that their job in Cyprus was very important, because as long as they are where they are, the politicians have time to negotiate. He also talked to both the Turkish Cypriot and Greek Cypriot negotiators.

Last year Mr Rydbeck was the Secretary General, Mr Waldheim's special charge d'affaires in North Western Africa.

After his visit to Cyprus, Mr Rydbeck went onto the Middle East to visit the Swedish Battalion there.

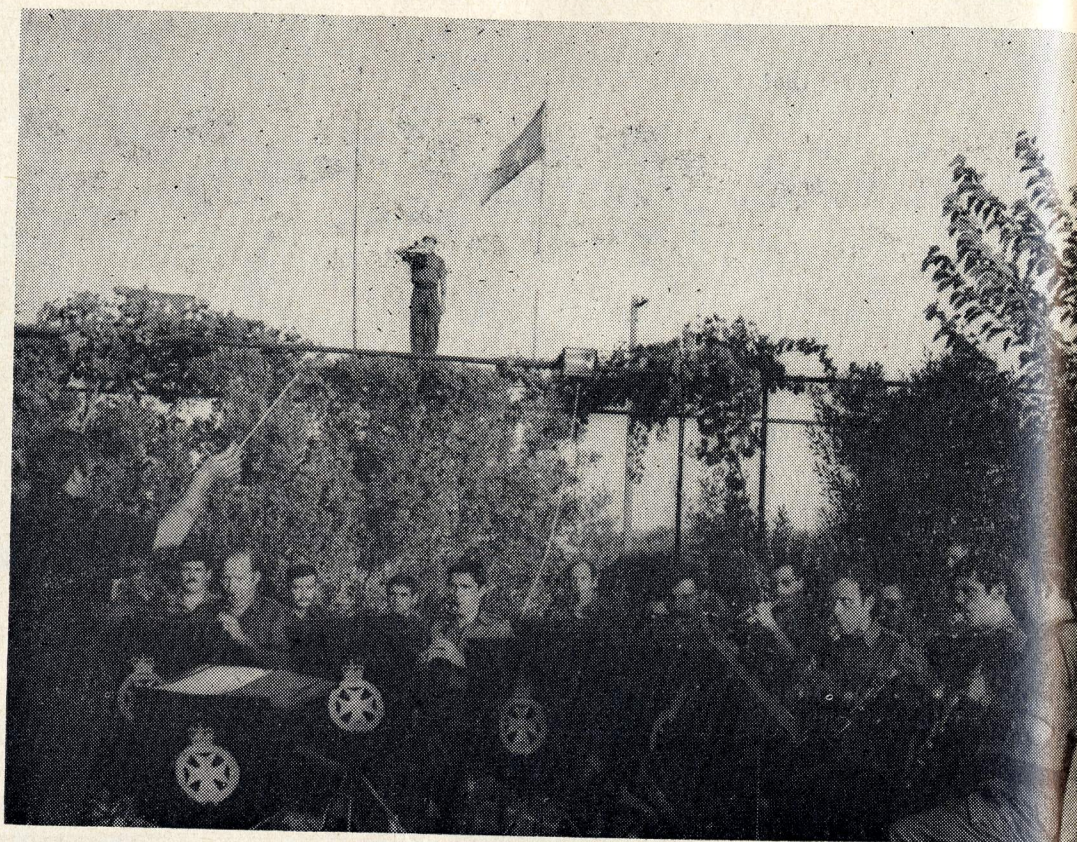

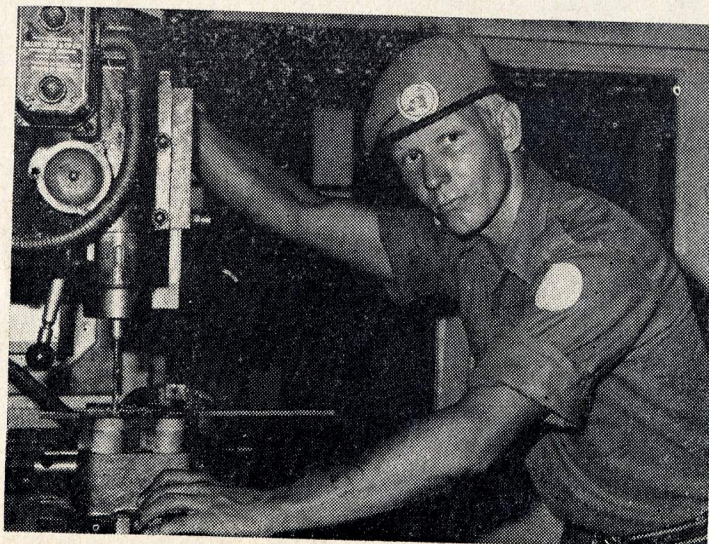

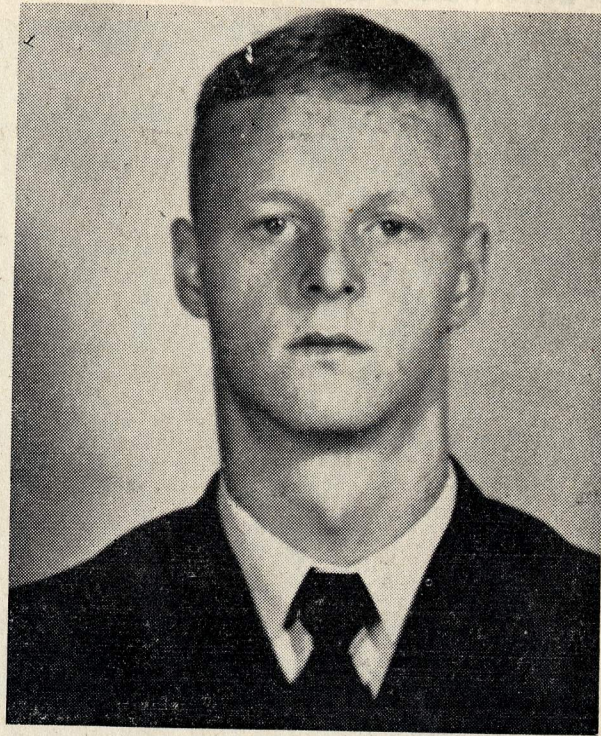
OP COMMANDERS CONFERENCE

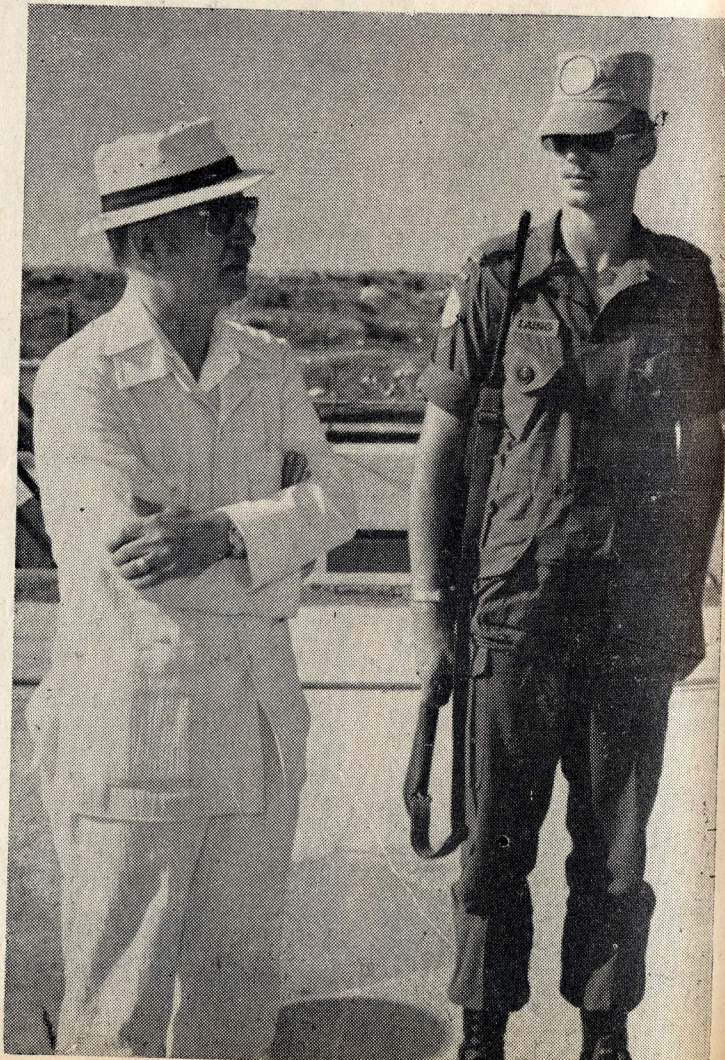

ENGLISH SUMMARY

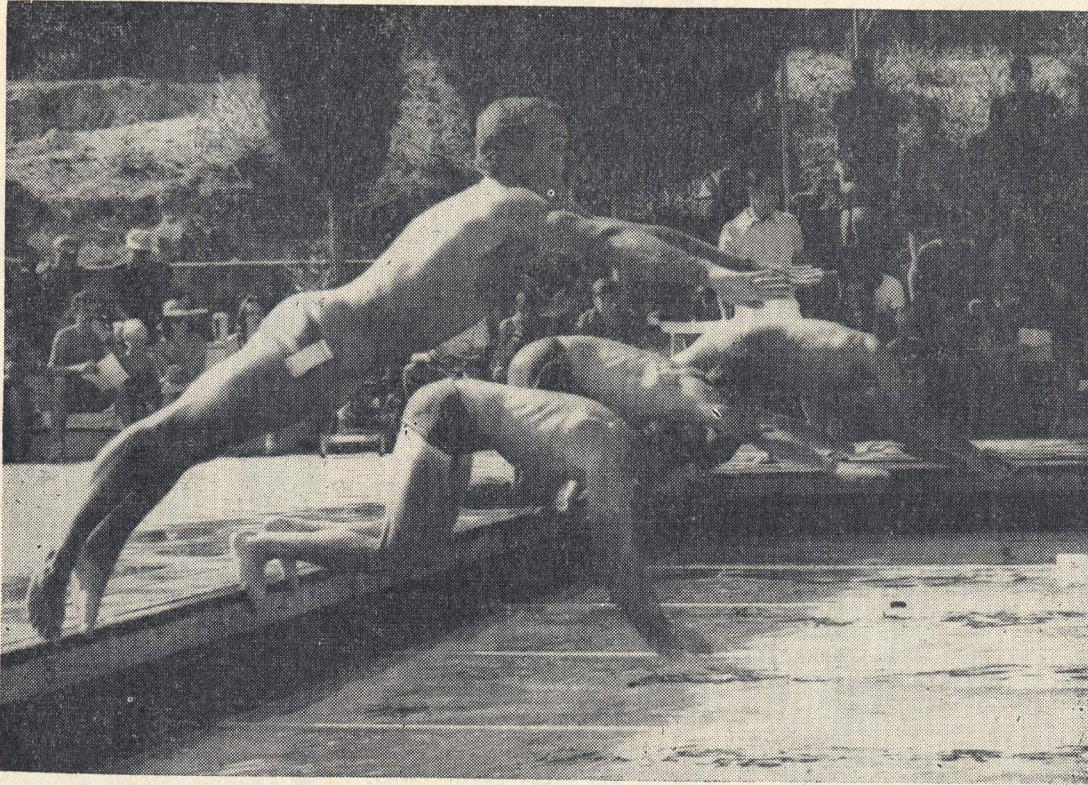

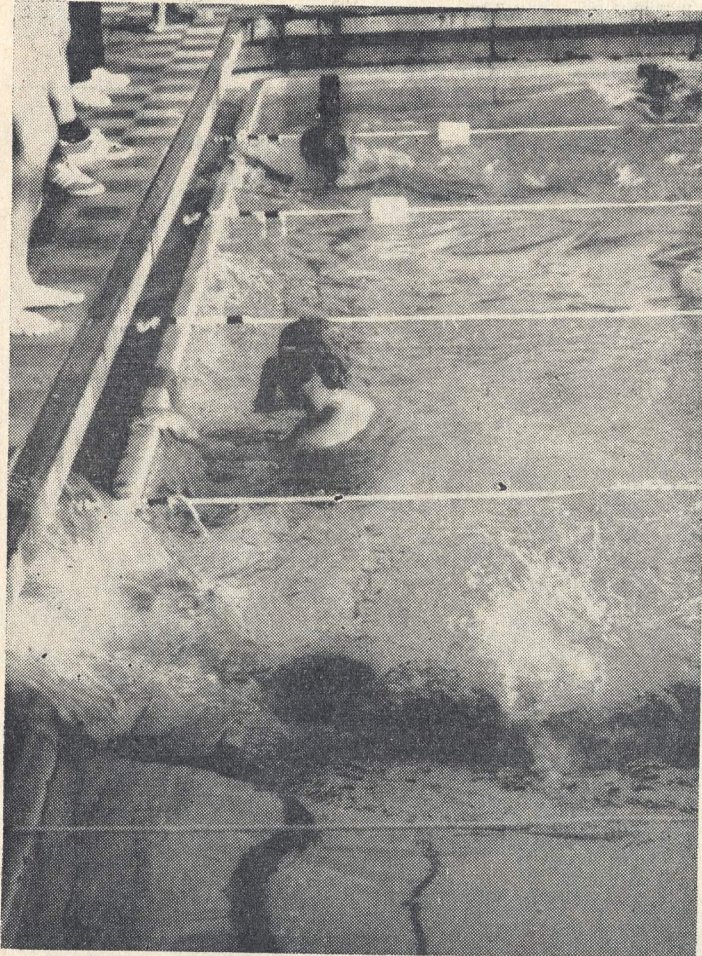

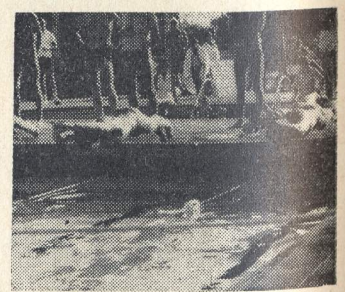
